Andrea Ross gave a start-to-finish expert demonstration on the value and technique of pastel painting, her main medium for over twenty years. Now you may know her prize-winning oil paintings, but she says that pastel was her teacher of colour. Because there is a great variety of shades available, colours pure, and sticks flexible and forgiving, pastel is a wonderful medium for artists new and experienced. She built up her subject for us on paper, showing her progress from gestures, lights and darks, and colour correction through subtle layering, until a skilful rendering of nature resulted. Interesting questions followed. Andrea teaches Tuesday mornings at the Creative Arts Centre, Stafford Rd. in Bell's Corners.
